Original cloth binding with title in gilt on spine and also in gilt the Tibetan title on the front cover, 175 pages, 10 plates, folding map, one small marking in the text, very good condition. Bailey used his accumulated holidays to make an epic journey following the Tsangpo from China through southern Tibet to India. As Bailey published his three books very late and the sensationalist newspaper reports about his trips had long been forgotten by then, he never attained the status as traveller as others got, who travelled much less. Taken together his journeys to Lhasa with Younghusband, and later in his functions for the Indian Political Service, his expedition to Gartok in Western Tibet following the Younghusband Mission and his later travels in Eastern and Southern Tibet he has probably seen more of Tibet than any other traveller from the West before 1959. This is his earliest book and becoming increasingly hard to find, as it has never been reprinted. Wonderful Association Copy - the copy of the Royal Central Asian Society with their library rules inside the front cover, no other library markings. Bailey has been Honorary Librarian for the Society in the 1940s.

Original softcover binding, 252 pages, illustrated throughout, very good condition. Catalogue of an exhibition at the Fondation Pierre Bergé - Yves Saint Laurent. Alain Bordier assembled with the help of Ulrich von Schroeder a comprehensive, museum quality collection and founded his private Tibet Museum at Gruyères, where he converted an old chapel as exhibition room. This catalogue is so far the best publication about this collection, which is very strong in the art of Western Tibet, Pala influenced early central Tibetan art and early art from Nepal, amongst others. The collection comprises also, quite uniquely, thanks to the good eye of Ulrich von Schroeder, two Thangkas and one sculpture in the idiosyncratic style of the 10. Karmapa Chos-dbyings rdo-rje. Several absolute stunning pieces, one of our favorites is no. 78, a sculpture of Aksobhya, made in Tibet of the 12th century but in a purely Pala style. First published in 1981 by Ulrich von Schroeder it was also sometime in the collection of Michael Henss, before it went back to von Schroeder and then to Bordier (provenance not described in the catalogue). Another magnificent piece is no 56, a 68 cm large

Manjushri sculpture, acquired by von Schroeder already in 1975 from the private Beasley museum - the most important piece of that collection, now slightly restored. The print run of this catalogue was apparently quite low, it immediately went out of print and is hard to find.

Good reprint of the 1894 original in the "Bibliotheca Himalayica" Series with a introduction specially written for this edition by Hugh Richardson (which is not present in the modern Indian reprints). Bower entered Tibet from the northern end of Ladakh and travelled in direction of Lhasa, which they almost reached before the Tibetans became aware of them. As they were hindered access to Lhasa Bower with his companions turned further north and went to Kham, therefrom to China. At that time Bower had already earned some fame as the Indian Government instructed him during a previous journey to Turkestan to discover and arrest the assassin who killed Andrew Dalglish on top of the Karakoram Pass. "All Bower was told of the whereabouts of the fugitive was ... that he was somewhere in Central Asia... a geographical term comprising a very large slice of the earth's surface". Bower's diary covers the whole journey from June 1891 to March 1892. The "hunting trip" was secretly sanctioned by the Viceroy of India, to counteract the Russian activities and to gain firsthand knowledge of the region. Thus, also a trained Pundit, Atma Ram, accompanied Bower. The Pundit was on the payroll of the Intelligence Branch of the Army Quartermaster-General. An important book. The 1894 original edition was actually preceded by a confidentially issued 1893 imprint with superior maps and illustrations. As this was circulated in official circles only and printed in an edition of 100 copies only, it is quite unavailable.

Still one of the best and most detailed travel books with an astonishing range of illustrations. The coloured plates are striking. Das' original texts appeared in Calcutta in 1881, Narrative of a Journey to Tashilumpo in 1879), 1885 (Narrative of a Journey to Lhasa in 1881-82) and 1887 (Narrative of a Journey round

Lake Yamdo (Palti), and in Lhokha, Yarlung, and Sakya in 1882) and were heavily rewritten by Rockhill (and thus losing Das' original "cogent, idiosyncratic and delightful" style, as described by Quaritch in their important Central Asia Catalogue of 1985 (Catalogue 1047), where they offered the whole set. and then published in 1902. The original prints were published only in a run of 100 each, the Tashilhunpo one in an edition of 25 only (and is thus not mentioned even in the newest edition of Yakushi) and are thus practicably unobtainable. We usually do not care for Indian reprints, but this was published in H. Kuloy's Bibliotheca Himalayica, the only decent series of books published at that time in India. No. 454 of a limited edition of 2000 copies. The first volume fittingly published in Harvard Kuloy's Bibliotheca Himalayica. Much nicer than the usual Indian reprints.

As he was not allowed to travel beyond the Kathmandu valley he worked with a team of Nepalese collectors, who compiled collections of natural history specimens for him, as well as of ethnological objects, art and manuscripts. He published widely, but almost only in long defunct journals. This collection of papers was first published in 1874. No. 549 of a limited edition of 1000 copies. Much better quality than newer reprints.

Thomson was appointed together with Richard Strachey and Cunningham to the Boundary Commission to determine the border between Ladakh and Tibet. Thomson's area was north of Leh and encompassed the Nubra and Shyok valleys. He wintered as first European in Baltistan and crossed as first Westener the Saser and Karakorum passes. He also was the first to travel into Ladakh using a route over Pir Pinjal. Reprint of the 1852 original edition, reprinting, unlike other Indian reprints, also the two maps of the original edition and additionally has 10 plates, not present in the original.

The plates show highly important south Tibetan Thangkas, strongly influenced by Newar art - generally believed to be the pinnacle of Tibetan art of the 15th century: no less than 4 of the 15 century Mandalas of the now famous Vajravali series and three portraits from the Ngor Lamdre lineage (compare hereto also David Jackson, The Nepalese Legacy in Tibetan Art, 2010, i.a. p. 1 - where Jackson mentions, that this book is of unusually large format and price).

Jackson also is wondering who has provided the necessary information for this catalogue, as Burawoy was specialised in Japanese art. To our knowledge Burawoy published only one other catalogue about Tibetan art (Peinture Lamaïque, 1976). In this it is mentioned that James Singer has written the historical note and gave the iconographical input and Denis Eysseric translated the Tibetan inscriptions - maybe these persons also helped with this catalogue.

Very rare - we find copies in public libraries only at Paris, Victoria & Albert Museum/London, Tibetinstitut Rikon, Völkerkundemuseum Zurich, Museum of Fine Arts Boston and Columbia University (a copy we had the honour to provide).

Hunter (31 July 1861 – 20 December 1946) was a Scottish Missionary, known for his disdain of missionaries of other denominations, working in Chinese Central Asia. Two fellow missionaries published his biography (Mildred Cable and Francesca French, George Hunter: Apostle of Turkestan, 1948). He worked for 57 years there, including 13 months spent in a Soviet secret police cell. This is a extremely scarce locally produced publication with text in Turki and English in Parallel. As described in the preface by Hunter, he printed it on a "small mimeograph" in Chinese Turkestan reproducing his readable handwriting. The text consists of a translation of the Qissas al-anbiya. "...being in a very remote part of the earth, and without a printing press, the best we could do was to take 100 copies of a small mimeograph ... we ask the reader to bear with us if a little difficult to decipher under the circumstances it is the best we can do." Cable, op.cit, describes the process: "His first effort as a translator had been made in the early years of his Central Asian life. It was the custom in that Moslem land to transcribe all religious books by hand. These manuscripts were not easy to come by, but he was able to secure one which was a standard theological work largely read by the Turki people in Sinkiang. The book was entitled Narratives of the Prophets, and it contained seventy-one articles dealing with the creation, the lives of the prophets, and ended with an account of the death of Mohammed and incidents regarding his disciples. There was one long chapter on Alexander the Great, while another on the various heresies of the early Church related that, according to one Christian sect, Jesus is God, that according to another He is the Son of God, and that according to yet another He is Son of the Trinity. [...] Hunter translated portions of this

book at different times and ended by producing a very quaint volume which was of considerable interest to the restricted public which knew anything about Sinkiang, its remarkable population and the beautiful language spoken by its Turki inhabitants. The coarse paper was made from local material, often from the leaves of the desert iris, and the format was the usual style of Chinese book, with each sheet written on one side only and folded back to back. The sheets were stitched together by a deft Chinese workman and made a neat volume. George Hunter had succeeded in buying a second- or third-hand duplicating machine, and a skilled writer transcribed the Turki text on the waxed stencil sheet while Hunter wrote the English translation below. Every sheet was rolled separately and the curious little volume went out in small quantities as its author and printer could find time to issue the tiny editions. A few copies even found their way to the Oriental bookshops near the British Museum in London." (Cable, pp. 58/59). The bookshop indicated was Arthur Probsthain, which closed a couple of years ago after a history of more than 100 years. Peter Hopkirk's copy sold in his Sotheby's auction in 1998 for GBP 2.600 net.
