Newer cloth binding with mounted original front wrapper, 100 pp., 8 plates (plus 1 full plate drawing), 74 photos and illustrations in the text, first and last two or three leaves with water mark, otherwise very good and clean condition. The book is complete with all plates; the plates are bound in the order as mentioned in the index; the printed plate numbers have a slightly different order - apparently, this was fixed only after the plates had been printed. This is the same as in other copies we have seen of this book. Kozlov (1863 - 1935) first travelled to Central Asia as member of Prejevalsky's 4th expedition to eastern Tibet in 1888. In 1893 he explored the Tien Shan with the Roborovskii expedition. In 1899 he lead his own expedition to Mongolia and Kham, where he travelled again in 1907. During this expedition he also made the famous excavation at Khara Khoto with the fantastic early Tibetan art finds. In 1923 he wanted to reach Lhasa but never made it. Kozlov describes in this book his encounters with the Dalai Lama whom he first met in 1905 in Urga/Mongolia, where the Dalai Lama fled because of the Younghusband mission. They met again in 1909 in Kumbum. Apart from the description of their meetings the book contains also a general description of Tibet, with some early photos from Lhasa, probably from Tsybikov. This book was never translated and is very rare. Another copy was already in 1997 offered by a London bookdealer for 1.850 GBP. From the library of the famous Russian geographer Lew Semjonowitsch Berg who published extensively on Central Asia with his name on the title.

Original cloth binding, 199 pages, 9 illustrations on plates, endpaper map, spine very sunned, covers with faint remains of sticker, internally some very occasional foxing, but very good condition. Charles S. Houston: "The French determined in 1951 to climb 25,645-foot Nanda Devi (first climbed in 1936), cross the mile-long ridge, and descend over East Nanda Devi (24,390 feet). This is a heroic plan more because of altitude, uncertainty of Himalayan weather, and length of ridge than because of technical problems. Duplat, expedition leader, was so obsessed by the grandeur of the plan that some of his party believed he would rather die in the attempt than fail. The attempt took place in June 1951 and Duplat and Vignes were last seen close to the summit of Nanda Devi. No trace of them was found, the presumption being that they perished from exhaustion on the long climb or fell from the ridge. The expedition was well conceived, congenial, and well run. Far too little time, however, was spent acclimatizing (Duplat spent only five days from Base Camp to accident, and the others only ten). Too little attention was paid to the experiences of their predecessors, and the porter caravan was unnecessarily large and complex. Despite these minor shortcomings, it was a good expedition, unusual because it ended amicably. The book has been translated clumsily, and the original French idiom is often obscure. There are many avoidable mis-spellings and a good many mis-statements of fact which could easily have been avoided by a little research. A good map and technical appendix would have added greatly to the book's value to climbers. It is, nevertheless, a very readable book, lively, sensitive, vivid, and refreshingly different from most mountaineering records." - Quite uncommon.

Original cloth binding, xxvi, 247 pages, 1 map, front cover loose, front free endpaper almost so, upper and lower part of spine missing (with the "H" of Hunza in the title which is printed there), corners rubbed, first few pages a little dog eared, in general inside a very good and fresh copy. Large format (ca. 35,5 x 25,5 cm). With interesting provenance, faint stamp of (probably) "War Office", further stamp of the "Intelligence Division" and withdrawn stamp of "Ministry of Defence / Whitehall Library" on title page, and the Intelligence Division stamp also on the rear of the map. The book is about "The Khajuná or Burishaski [Burushaski] Language (Spoken in Hunza, Nagyr, and Part of Yasin)", with chapters on Vocabulary in Common Use, Dialogues in Khajuna compared with various Dialects of Shina, Miscellaneous Sentences, Dialogues in English, Urud Persian and Khajuna. Khajuna Songs, Legends, Fables, etc. and a Grammatical Sketch. Gottlieb Wilhelm Leitner (1840 - 1899) was born in Hungary and became already at the age of 23 professor in London for Arabic and Islamic Law. He spent some 20 years in India, where he was instrumental in the foundation of the University of the Punjab. After his return he commissioned the building of one of the first Mosques in Western Europe, the Shah Jahan Mosque in London. He spent only very little time in Hunza, but published extensively about it. For some reason all of his books are very rare in trade. This book was originally published in 1889 in Calcutta, both editions are rare. Probably Leitner brought unbound copies of this book back to England and had the title page and the short content list exchanged; pp. xv to xxvi, describing the composition of the book is also new, further the map was added. Otherwise the original sheets were used, as shown i.a. by the imprint on the last page mentioning that this book was actually printed by the India Central Printing Office in 1889 in an edition of 500 copies (only half of the last "0" is printed because of a defect in the type, both is the first and second edition. That the same sheets were used is shown also by other printing irregularities). This book was published with a "Supplement" entitled "Dardistan in 1866, 1886 and 1893" which is actually a separate book, not present here. Rare in the trade.

Original gilt decorated cloth binding, xxviii, 478 pages, 24 plates (many of which are folding colour maps), very good condition, the maps very fresh. Phillimore wrote the history of the Survey of India in 5 volumes. The 5th volume was immediately withdrawn upon publication as it provided too much information about the Chinese Indian frontier for India's Governments taste. In the other volumes all aspects of the survey are described for the period covered in the respective volume, so each volume is complete in itself. In this volume the progress of the surveys at the beginning of the 19th century is described. Also some work beyond India as such, like the work done during the Nepal War of 1814-16 and Moorcroft's journey to western Tibet and Manasarowar. There is a Nepal map on plate 8 drawn from surveys of 1802-3, a map of the Upper Ganges from 1808, for which special permission was obtained from Nepal and a map showing the frontier of Gurwal

with 3rd Dalai Lama's original seal print!

Original cloth binding with dust jacket and illustrated slipcase, 303 pages, illustrated throughout, all edges gilt (!), as new condition. Full text in Chinese, Tibetan and English - very unusual for a monograph as this. Even so the Potala is the most famous building of Tibet, there are few books which document it properly. This is the only book we know of showing the mural paintings from the 16th century to the early 20th century, when the tomb chapel of the 13th Dalai Lama was built. Highly important therefore. There are few firmly dated paintings from the early 20th century and these provide an excellent basis to compare with Thangka paintings. Intriguingly, the publisher also included on a tipped in piece of handmade paper an original print from the large official seal of the 3rd Dalai Lama, Sonam Gyatso, who lived from 1543 to 1588. Decidedly uncommon, we find it in public libraries only at British Library, Universities of Cambridge and Zurich, State Libraries of Bavaria and Denmark, and at Berlin.

In Russian. Quite uncommon, we find copies only at the Sorbonne and Lyon.

Hornblow, who published i.a. an article on climbing in the Karakorum ("KHINYANG CHHISH, The Himalayan Journal 1962). Journal of a hunting trip in 1898 in the Indian Himalayas, where the author and his wife travelled i.a. in Kulu, Lahoul, visiting Kyelang where they were entertained by the Moravian missionaries Mr and Mrs Heyde, and over the Zoji La to Baltistan. Reading this journal one gets the impression that it is a middle aged couple, inexperienced in travelling. One of the few books where actually a dandy was used to carry the author's wife, Nest, over a long distance. One learns only later, that the author was only 27 at the time he made this trip.

When Younghusband came there during the British Military Mission to Lhasa in 1903/1904 he was greeted in Yatung by Mrs Taylor. The book is undated, but it must have been published after June 1897 because the text prints a letter dating from then. She visited England and Scotland in 1897, when she sold a collection of "curiosas" to the Edinburgh Museum of Science and Art - so also a good association. So it is quite likely that she used this visit to also arrange for the publication of this book. The Hopkirk copy (compare Sotheby's, Sale 13 October 1998, lot 392 had an ownership inscription dated 1899. Still no copy in the British Library - we find copies of this original book only at the libraries of Erfurt, Cambridge, Durham and Glasgow. According to Jisc also no copy at Edinburgh, but, as mentioned this copy with due discarding stamps of the National Library of Scotland.. A rare book. One of the big London booksellers sold a copy in 2016 for GBP 1.500.
